Dreath Wizard

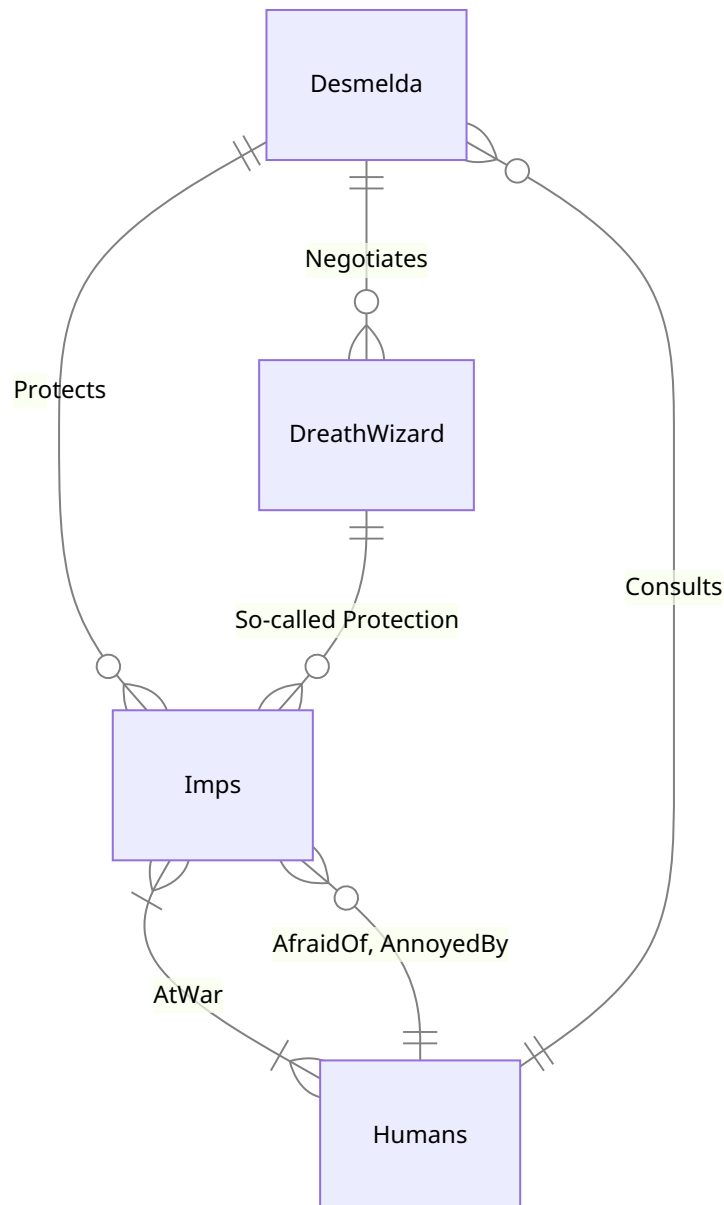
Dreath Wizard is a character who is not entirely trusted by Desmelda. Despite this, he agrees to protect the imps after they are relocated.
